What a busy week it has been! The children have coped really well with being back in our class bubble and all the changes from our usual routines. They have really enjoyed meeting Ms Morgan and telling her about themselves, Ms Morgan says she's had a lovely week and feels like she's been here forever.

In Literacy we have been learning the story of The Three Billy Goats Gruff. We have been practising ordering pictures from the story and retelling it using actions. The children have been drawing story plans to help them retell each detail and today we have had great fun 'hot seating' some of the characters. Next week they will begin to adapt the story and make up their own new version!

In DT the children have been continuing with their sewing – they have all made amazing progress with this and many have now almost finished sewing their Binca pattern. They will now use these skills to sew features on to their fabric faces, which we hope to display in the Pre Studio during the Art Exhibition.

In PE this week we went on 'A Journey to the Jungle' and had great fun trying to move around like different animals. The children then practised moving up, down, over and around the apparatus using different animal movements.

Due to not being able to split into our usual Read, Write, Inc groups we have run our sessions slightly differently this week. The children have still been practising their coloured RWI book in a small group situation but we have not had a focused phonics input for each group as they would usually. We hope to be able to return to our usual way of working very soon though.
