### **Re Autumn term- return to school**

I am writing to provide some information about the start of the new school term. We welcome Mrs Dix as Deputy Headteacher, Miss Varley as Yr 1 & 2 teacher, Mrs Morgan as Yr 6 teacher and Mrs Collins as Primary PPA teacher. Mr Gentle has joined the school Site and Premises team as Cleaner and two further new teachers have joined us on supply: Mr Nicholas as PE teacher and Mr Franks for Humanities.

We look forward to welcoming the majority of our pupils back to school tomorrow and the school day will start as usual at 8.25am and pupils can be dropped off from 8.15am. Reception class children start back on **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> September** and pre-school children join us on **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> September**.

Parents of children in Years 1 & 2 will need to take them to The Meadow on School Lane at from 8.15am and all other pupils should use the playground entrances on School Lane as usual.

Years 1 & 2 and Years 5 & 6 as larger classes will largely be taught in year group classes this year. Their teachers, Miss Varley & Mrs Gilyead (Yr 1& 2) and Miss Simeone & Mrs Morgan (Yr 5 & 6), will hold meetings early in the school year to provide parents with detailed information about timetables and curriculum & lesson content.

Please note that pupils in **Year 1 & 2** as well as **Year 9 & 10** are timetabled for **PE tomorrow** and will need to bring their PE kits. Sea Swimming classes are currently being organised by Mrs Etheredge and further information about these will be provided early next week.

We will publish Key Dates for this term on the school website and these will include amongst other things: Prize Giving Events, Harvest Festival, Assembly dates and Open Mornings.

The States of Alderney have asked me to share an update on the school bus situation. They are still not in a position to offer a school bus service and will be working in the coming weeks to look at how to address this in the long term.

We look forward to a busy and successful 2022-23 school year and hope that for the first time since 2020, it will be uninterrupted by COVID and that we are given a great opportunity to move forward with our plans to continue to ensure that all of our learners meet their full potential.
