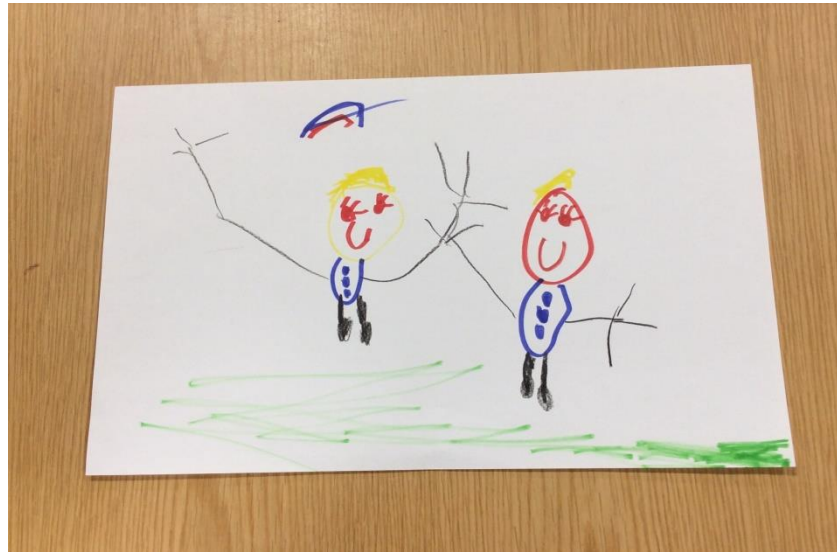


In September I will be moving
on to the Reception class.

8.25 am to 2.50 pm.

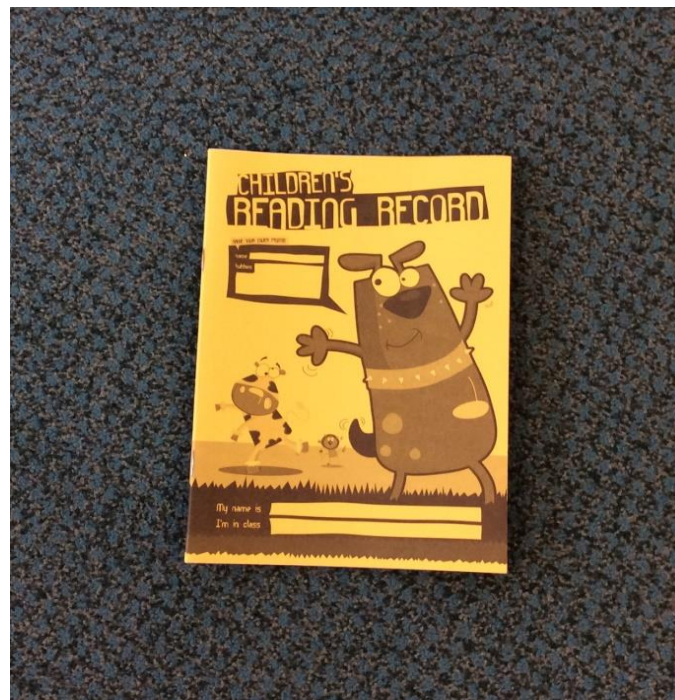
My teacher will be Mrs Costello and my learning support assistant (LSA) will be Miss Phillips.



I will bring my book bag to school every day to carry my books and letters. My bag is the colour of my house team and I can win points for my team. Red= Casquets, blue=Burhou, green= Ortac.



I will have short pieces of homework to complete. At first this will be practising my sounds (phonics) at home. Later, my family will listen to me read every night. I will have a book for my family to write comments in. My family should check this book each day for messages and also they can write to my teacher there.



These things will be the same as Foundation 1 class:

- I will receive a copy of my Learning Journey by email each month.
- I will visit the school library once a week to choose 3 books to share at home. I should return them the following week.
- I will still have a school water bottle which is washed each day and sent home at each holiday.
- I will continue to follow the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum.
- I should still bring a healthy snack each day.

These things will be different to Foundation 1 class:

- I can stay for lunch each day if I choose to. I should bring a healthy lunch in a lunch bag.
- I can still choose to have milk, but it will cost £10.00 per term.
- I will wear full school uniform, the sweatshirt is the same as Foundation 1 class.
- I will take part in a short taught session of phonics (sounds) and maths each morning and my teachers will hear me read at school.
- In the morning I should be dropped off in the bottom playground and I will be collected from the path near the Early Years play area at home time.
- I will need a PE T shirt in my house team colour, blue shorts and black pumps. I will keep these in a bag on my coat peg and bring them home each holiday for a wash!
- After a few weeks I will join in assemblies.
- I will not be carrying out supervised tooth brushing in school.
