Next Friday, the 18 of March is Red Nose Day.

Pupils will be able to purchase the noses as soon as they arrive for £1.50 during registration times next week (8.25am to 8.50am). Form B will bring them to classrooms. They may be worn to school next Friday and all proceeds will go to 'Red Nose Day'.

On the same day, Friday 18 March, we will also be holding a 'blue and yellow' non-uniform day and cake sale.

The blue and yellow colours represent the Ukrainian flag and we are wearing them is support of the people of Ukraine who have been displaced by the war in their country. We will show our support with a group photo at school. Miss Alison is in touch with a charity organisation in Romania where she used to work. This organisation is supporting families escaping over the border from Ukraine. We are asking pupils for a donation of £1 to wear non-uniform in the colours of blue and yellow.
